Quora High School serves students in grades 9-12+ with Emotional Behavioral Disorders (EBD), Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD), and Developmental Cognitive Disabilities (DCD).

Project Return is a general education program for students who need alternatives to out-of-school suspension or expulsion.

WELS South is designed for students aged 18-21 who have Developmental Cognitive Disabilities (DCD), Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD), and physical or other health impairment disabilities.

East View Academy is an area learning center (ALC) where students can reach their educational and career goals in a non-traditional learning environment. Students receive assistance in meeting graduation requirements and have opportunities to gain vocational skills and work experience.

The Assessment Center is a temporary school placement for students to receive a comprehensive evaluation of students' skills and school functioning. This is best for students whose teachers and families have unanswered questions regarding their educational needs.
